**Footnotes**

BRADERSTER closest to the pace off the inside, challenged before a half, drew off when ready into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. PROUD STRIKE forwardly placed, came three wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid for the place. BOUNDLESS HEART within striking distance three wide, made a run at the leaders from that path on the second turn but tired in the drive. MR BLACKTHORN set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. HIP FOUR SIXTYNINE outrun early four wide, improved his position on the second turn but lacked a late bid. CAT'S DESTINY close up along the inside, tired. FIGHT THE TIDE within reach off the rail, failed to respond in the stretch. THUNDER QUAY broke slowly, was outrun for a half, raced four wide on the second turn and was no threat. LIBERAL SPIN outrun early five wide, stayed in that path on the second turn and was no factor. COWDRAY PARK made an early five wide to a forward position, held on well to the stretch and gave way. ALE was no threat.
