TOMORROWS CAT went up to vie for the lead early while outside of WHIST, took over concluding the second turn, was headed in the upper stretch from the outside by WINTER TIME, then, after the rider dropped his whip at the furlong grounds, dug in gamely to prevail. WINTER TIME stalked the leaders from early on while four wide, reached the front briefly between calls in the upper stretch but was outfinished. WHIST gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with the winner until the stretch and weakened. INFORMATION HIWAY broke in the air, was outrun for six furlongs and improved position while not a serious threat. WILD DREAM saved ground to no avail. CHALK IT UP raced in a striking position for six furlongs and weakened.
