Footnotes

DOLLAR BILL maneuvered inside early, saved ground for six furlongs, worked his way out to rally five wide entering the stretch, caught front-running HOLIDAY THUNDER a furlong out, took over and edged clear late under energetic handling. HOLIDAY THUNDER tracked front-running PERCY HOPE from early on while four wide, moved to the fore on the second turn, made the pace into the final furlong and couldn't handle DOLLAR BILL late. GIFT OF THE EAGLE, in contention while following the leaders five or six wide from early on, loomed solid threat for the final furlong but came up empty. UNBRIDLED TIME broke slowly and in the air, was outrun for six furlongs and could not threaten while improving position outside. VROOM VROOM went up early to press front-running PERCY HOPE, continued close up until the stretch and tired. PERCY HOPE gained the lead inside, made the pace for five furlongs and weakened soon after.
