**Footnotes**

MAGNA GRADUATE went up at once to press front-running GO NOW in hand four wide, inched to the fore a stride before going six furlongs, was displaced on the front end at the quarter-mile ground from the outside by SUAVE, regained the edge soon after, battled on even terms while inside SUAVE the remainder and proved gamely best under left-handed urging while appearing to come out on or just past the wire and bumping with that foe. SUAVE, always well placed and four or five wide moved after the winner nearing the final quarter, stuck a head in front, lost the edge back to MAGNA GRADUATE soon after, then was outfinished in a long drive when bumped on or past the wire. PERFECT DRIFT, reserved early and three wide, briefly lacked room leaving the three furlong marker, worked his way between foes five wide approaching the stretch, swung out eight or nine wide for the drive, loomed prominently for the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. ANDROMEDA'S HERO, outrun for six furlongs, advanced four wide on the far turn, remained four wide entering the stretch and offered a mild gain. M B SEA settled in hand early and was hung four wide into the first turn, worked his way to the rail on the backstretch, continued inside when rallying into the stretch and closed some ground at the end. A. P. ARROW, in hand three wide early, eased out six or seven wide on the backstretch, inched closer nearing the stretch, angled ten wide when straightened for the drive and improved position while not a serious threat. PURIM, unhurried and inside from early on, made a menacing move approaching the stretch, eased out five wide for the drive but flattened out at the end. ALUMNI HALL gained a striking position in behind rivals three or four wide early, eased a bit wider when making his run on the far turn but weakened when straightened for the drive. GO NOW gained a slight edge three wide early, battled with the winner while inside that one, lost the edge to MAGNA

GRADUATE just before going six furlongs and weakened. TOTAL IMPACT (CHI) tired after six furlongs. CHIPPEWA TRAIL tracked the pace five wide for three-quarters and weakened thereafter. STOLEN TIME faded on the far turn.
