FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each on or before November 11, 2006 or by supplementary nomination of \$10,000 each at time of entry. \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. The Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes winner will automatically be nominated to the 2007 Triple Crown, as far as nomination fee. Closed Saturday, November 11, 2006 with 29 nominations.

Footnotes

TIZ WONDERFUL went up soon after the start to vie for the lead outside of front-running STARBASE three or four wide under light rating, dueled with that one into the far turn, briefly reached the front between calls, was headed from the outside just prior to going six furlongs by ANY GIVEN SATURDAY, recaptured the advantage when straightened for the drive and was under extreme pressure to prevail. ANY GIVEN SATURDAY, tucked in behind foes four wide early, eased out on the backstretch to race between horses four wide, moved menacingly to reach the front just before going three-quarters, lost the edge back to the winner, then refused to yield in a long drive while superior to the others. DOMINICAN, within easy striking distance and five wide, made a strong run approaching the final quarter while outside the top two but weakened when straightened for the drive. GOING BALLISTIC settled inside early, made a run from between foes three wide on the far turn, continued three wide into the lane while remaining a factor but was empty the last eighth. JOE GOT EVEN drifted out at the start, raced four or five wide, made a mild run nearing the stretch and flattened out. STARBASE gained a slim advantage inside early, dueled with the winner until midway on the far turn and weakened. WHAT A TALE broke in the air, was steadied when appearing to be climbing in behind rivals approaching the first turn and never seriously menaced. U D GHETTO raced five wide much of the way and weakened nearing the stretch. MR BLACKSTONE raced near the inside and tired on the far turn.
