**Footnotes**

TEUFLESBERG stumbled at the start, quickly gained a forward position inside, took over from the rail nearing the final furlong and drew off when kept to his task. CARNACKS CHOICE, in hand while up close between foes four wide to the stretch, couldn't threaten the winner late as second best. POINT OF REASON, within striking distance always and five wide, couldn't muster a closing threat. SENTRY broke sharply while drifting out, sprinted clear three wide, made the pace to the stretch and tired. FRONT COURT, outrun to the stretch, came out eight or nine wide for the drive and improved position. FORTUNE HUNTER tracked the pace four wide to the stretch and flattened out. INDIAN CAMP raced near the inside, eased out four wide for the drive but offered no closing bid. OUT OF THE SKIP bobbed at the start, raced near the inside and wasn't a factor. NATIONAL DAY, five or six wide, never menaced. JOSEPH G tired on the turn.
