STAR OF DAVID pulled to contention along the inside under a snug hold, angled out to find room entering the stretch and quickly drew away once clear. PRIZE MASTER was away alertly and angled in to set the pace, was no match for the winner, but kept on willingly to hold the place. KENTUCKY HOLIDAY pressed the pace two wide, gained a narrow lead with a quarter to run, but weakened during the drive and settled for a minor award. PERUVIAN HERO broke in the air, was unhurried into stride, got through toward the inside entering the stretch, made a mild rally but failed to threaten. FLEET DAYJUR stalked the pace four wide, ranged up to make a mild bid leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. FURILLO settled in the second flight and failed to respond. OTTAVIANI was through early.
