TO TELL THE TRUTH stalked the pace three deep, drew even with five-sixteenths to run, opened clear entering the stretch and widened through the drive. PRESENTS FOR BERTI attended the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the second turn to make his move, was no match for the winner but kept on willingly to earn the place. SIR JOCK vied for the lead two wide, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to safely hold the show. GOOD QUESTION disputed the pace along the inside for six furlongs and faded. SATYRS was unhurried into stride, came three wide to make a belated gain but was never a factor. COPPER BOTTOM failed to respond. BULLNOSE BRICK saved ground to no avail. SOLOMON'S SONG was through early.
