GREAT ATTACK set the pace off the inside, repulsed a bid by CASH REFUND late on the turn, drew clear into the stretch and held sway late. AFFIRMATIF close up along the inside, angled out a bit for the drive and rallied willingly late. GRAND TRAVERSE within striking distance off the inside, lodged a mild bid. MORALIST never far back three wide, dropped back a bit into the stretch then made a late gain. CASH REFUND forwardly placed four wide, made a run at the winner late on the turn but tired in the drive. HOLD THE SALT prominent off the inside, tired. ST. JOE was outrun four wide.
