ENGINE ROOM set the pace off the inside, responded when challenged on the second turn and proved narrowly best. LAKE PLEASANT outrun for a half, made a good middle move along the inside, split rivals approaching the stretch, moved back to the inside in midstretch and was gaining late. CUSTERS LAST STAND reserved early, advanced three wide on the second turn and made a good late gain. INDY NEWS unhurried for a half, advanced four wide on the second turn and made a good late gain. STAGE SUCCESS reserved early, raced in the three path on the second turn but lodged only a mild late bid. TIME SENSITIVE forwardly placed from the start, challenged three wide on the second turn, battled into the final furlong and tired late. BK'S OTHER

BROTHER outrun for six furlongs, found his best stride too late. JUJU outrun to the stretch, was no real threat. MR. REALISTIC within striking distance off the inside, faded. FIRST GOLD forced the early pace three wide, gained the inside on the second turn and gave way. FIRST NATIONAL within reach three wide, moved out a path on the second turn and faded in the drive. WIREMAN close up for a half, stopped.
