Footnotes

TRACI'S THUNDER tracked the pace three wide under a snug hold, assumed command entering the stretch and drew clear. IN THE FRAME was allowed to settle, circled five wide and was along in time to earn the place. CHARMA POSSE dueled for the lead two wide, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. LEATHER LACES stalked the pace off of the inside, came four wide but lacked the needed late response. KENTUCKY PEACHES chased the pace three wide, drifted out four wide but flattened entering the stretch. HOT VISION was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, shifted out four wide and improved position. NEON LIPSTICK was allowed to settle, came six wide and finished with a belated gain. BOM BABY angled in to save ground, moved up to make a mild bid between horses entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. CHAMP LAILA failed to respond. BELL OF BUDDHA dueled for the lead along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. BARBATINA was outrun. NINEWITHIT was through early.
