MALIBU SUNRISE set the pace off the inside, stayed out in the three path on the second turn, repulsed a bid by the runner up in the stretch and edged clear under steady urging. ONE HOT GATOR closest to pace, 3 wide, 4 path 2nd turn, made a run at the winner once in the stretch, could not stay with that one late but held on to be second best. CHINA MELISSA angled out wide late on the first turn when close up, stayed in that path on the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. HONEY C forwardly placed along the inside, stayed on well to the stretch and gave way. LAWYER BROCKMEYER outrun early, raced in the five path on the second turn and was no threat. PRIVATEMARKETVALUE six wide on the first turn, was no threat. MAKENZIE'S MAGIC

hopped a bit at the start, was reserved along the inside, moved between rivals on the second turn and could not menace. RIP SNORTER within striking distance in the three path, moved to the rail on the second turn and faded. REAL OBVIOUS four wide on the first turn, when within striking distance, held on well to the stretch and faded. GOLDEN MEADOW five wide on the first turn, was no factor.
