Footnotes

OXBOW set the pace off the inside, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. LOOKING COOL bumped at the start, was reserved early, made a four wide run on the turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. SAINT X. close up from the start, dropped back on the turn then improved his position along the rail. MOON BACK MORE drifted out at the start, raced within reach off the inside but lacked a late bid. KAMCHATKA within striking distance early inside, moved off the rail midway through the turn and was no late threat. KITTEN GOES PRO lost his footing at the start, forced the pace inside the winner, dropped back a bit and angled out to the three path midway through the turn but tired in the drive. SOUTHERN BLAST outrun early, raced three wide on the turn and showed late interest. ROYAL WARRIOR outrun early, raced in the four path on the turn and was never a threat. HORSE FELDHAUS drifted out a bit at the start then was carried out into HASHAAR, raced close up four wide, and tired. GIACOSLEW within striking distance, raced four wide late on the turn and faded. BASHAAR forced back at the start, was outrun.
