TOMISUE'S DELIGHT, unhurried early while outrun and out in the strip, commenced her rally in the three path approaching the stretch, came wider once in the stretch and finished with good speed to be clear. TOP SECRET, closest to the pace off the inside, challenged on the second turn, responded when displaced in midstretch and outfinished SILENT ESKIMO for the place. SILENT ESKIMO sprinted clear to set the pace, responded willingly when displaced and held on gamely late. FRENCH BRAIDS, forwardly placed inside, lacked a solid closing bid. LU RAVI, within striking distance, moved closer four wide on the second turn, gained command with a furlong to go but tired late. MISTY HOUR, within striking distance early, raced three wide on the second turn, came out a bit more in midstretch but lacked a late bid. BAREFOOT DYANA, within striking distance off the inside, had little left late. TIMELY BROAD was outrun.
