REFLECT THE MUSIC moved up soon after the start to stalk pacesetting TEMPESTINA, followed that one four wide into the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. TEMPESTINA broke sharply and quickly opened a clear advantage, was a bit rank on the backstretch while racing in hand three or four wide, settled on the turn, showed the way until deep stretch but couldn't last. HOW COULD YOU, well placed inside from early on, loomed boldly inside the top two and hung. DORM, within striking distance into the stretch, held her position along the inside while unable to menace. DRIVE THRU BLUES, also within striking position while outside the leaders, lacked a closing bid. KRIS IS IT exchanged bumps with PRINCESS T at the start, was outrun till the stretch, then wasn't a factor while passing tired ones. CUBBING'S RUBY was outrun. IDOL GIFT was never prominent. TWILIGHT STREET gave way on the turn. PRINCESS T exchanged bumps with KRIS IT IT at the start and faded upon going a half. PRINCESS T and KRIS IS IT wore nasal strips.
