VEGAS PROSPECTOR lunged at the start while breaking awkwardly, quickly recovered to race within easy striking distance, rallied five wide into the stretch and was hard ridden to best DREAMY MAIDEN. The latter, wearing a nasal strip, raced within easy striking distance, rallied four wide leaving the turn, gained a slight edge, then failed to contain the winner late. EXPENSIVE SLEW, outspinted for a half, followed the winner six wide into the stretch, then came up empty when the test came. STORMIN HANNA gained the lead inside early, surrendered the advantage to MARSHESLEW before going a half, held on well until the stretch and tired. CHITKA, within striking distance and saving ground much of the way, was forced to steady leaving the three-sixteenths pole when placed in tight quarters by MARSHESLEW, stumbled and was finished. MARSHESLEW contested the pace from the start while outside of STORMIN HANNA, gained a clear advantage on the turn, then, while tiring leaving the three-sixteenths pole, leaned in tightening it up on CHITKA.
