Footnotes

POPULAR PATRIOT, never far back while between foes, moved five or six wide to gain a slight edge approaching the final furlong, then was hard ridden the remainder. BOOK THE CAT, outsprinted early, raced inside to the stretch, swung out six wide for the drive and was going well at the end. MAKIN' ANGELS, well placed in behind the leaders into the lane, lacked a final response. SENSATIONAL CHARM, within striking distance inside to the stretch, angled five wide for the drive but lacked a serious late response. ICE CREAM LADY, never far back, tracked the leaders five or six wide, made a menacing move approaching the eighth pole but flattened out when the test came. GOLDRUSH GIRL moved up early to vie for the lead between foes, stuck her head in front a quarter-mile out but faltered the last eighth. BRICK SALTHOUSE gained a slim lead early, edged inside, dueled to the stretch and weakened thereafter. COOL GHOUL raced forwardly between foes four or five wide into the stretch and faltered. PLEASANT MOLLY was outrun. OAKS, bumped at the start, faded leaving the turn. GINGER RAPIDS, six or seven wide throughout, was done upon going a half. EASY E never was close after coming out at the start and bumping with OAKS.
