**Footnotes**

DON'T GET MAD, outrun early, commenced a sweeping six wide run on the turn, reached the front in the upper stretch, then drove clear late. WAHRAN, outrun early, moved five or six wide approaching the stretch, drifted in bumping several times with ELECTRIC LIGHT, then continued on as second best. ROYAL MOMENT, close up between foes early, angled to the rail entering the upper stretch, was checked in deep stretch when lacking room and lacked a final account. CAN'T TRICK JAKE contested the pace from early on while dueling three or four wide outside of FAVORITE FUN, held on well into the upper stretch and weakened. REGARDLESSLY, outrun for a half, split foes five wide entering the stretch and offered a minor gain. ELECTRIC LIGHT tracked the dueling leaders early while four or five wide, was bumped repeatedly entering the upper stretch by WAHRAN and forced to steady in tight quarters when that on drifted in, then weakened. BRIGHTON BULL, within striking distance and between rivals to the stretch, angled out six wide for the drive but lacked a response. VENDAGE never was prominent. FAVORITE FUN contested the pace inside for a half and gradually weakened. BIANCONI'S BOY raced in contention for a half while five or six wide and tired. CLEAR TO CLOSE bobbed at the start and tired on the turn.
