**Footnotes**

SUCCESSFUL DAN was rank to place and fought restraint between horses through the opening half, was bottled up between rivals through the second turn, lacked room entering the stretch, bulled his way out bumping REDDING COLLIERY near the three-sixteenths pole, created a clear path and kicked on gamely soon after, responded willingly when GIANT OAK ranged up from the outside and outfinished that one after battling through the final sixteenth. GIANT OAK settled in hand, advanced four wide through the second turn, shifted out five wide entering the stretch, loomed large with a furlong to run but just missed in a good effort. REDDING COLLIERY contended between horses four wide, moved with the winner through the second turn, was bumped hard when SUCCESSFUL DAN came out with three-sixteenths to run, flattened thereafter and settled for the minor award. DEMARCATION stalked the pace four wide, launched his bid leaving the second turn, drew even entering the stretch, veered in bumping his stable mate inside the three-sixteenths pole, was straightened away but went evenly thereafter. WIN WILLY was unhurried into stride, advanced off of the inside through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and improved position through the drive. DUKE OF MISCHIEF attended the pace three wide, drew even between horses with a quarter to run, but weakened during the drive and faded. BRASS HAT was shuffled back at the start, was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a belated gain but failed

to threaten. APART settled saving ground, moved up along the inside on the second turn, shifted out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. REGAL RANSOM opened a clear lead to set the pace, was collared with three furlongs to run, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. STATELY VICTOR bobbed at the start, was allowed to settle four wide but was never a factor. DUBIOUS MISS was forwardly placed, bid between horses three wide, was bumped and steadied when his stable mate DEMARCATION came in near the three-sixteenths pole and dropped back. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF REDDING COLLIERY AGAINST SUCCESSFUL DAN FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE STRETCH, THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY AND DEEMED SUCCESSFUL DAN BE DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED THIRD FOR INTERFERENCE NEAR THE THREE-SIXTEENTHS POLE, ADDITIONALLY THE STEWARDS RULED THAT DEMARCATION BE DISQUALIFIED FROM FOURTH AND PLACED LAST FOR VEERING IN AND BOTHERING HIS STABLEMATE DUBIOUS MISS INSIDE THE THREE-SIXTEENTHS POLE.
