Footnotes

CHANNELING made a middle move four wide, drew even inside the three-eighths pole, fought on determinedly and was inching away gamely late. GUARDED ENTRANCE was bumped entering the first turn, kept on well and disputed the pace along the inside through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way in the final yards. GIHON was unhurried into stride, closed the gap on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, worked his way to the outside between rivals and finished willingly to earn the show. KINGOFTHEBLUEGRASS was caught in tight and bumped repeatedly with WORTH A BUCK entering the first turn, pulled to contention off of the inside, angled out four wide leaving the second turn but lacked a response when called upon. GRAND STAGE was hustled along four wide to attend the pace, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. TIMELY PURSUIT was away alertly, angled in tightening up KINGOFTHEBLUEGRASS and WORTH A BUCK, set the pressured pace three wide to the stretch and gave way. COFFEE BREAK was unhurried into stride, responded when roused with seven-sixteenths to run, circled seven wide and made a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. PARTY HARD settled in hand three wide but lacked a response when put to pressure. WORTH A BUCK was in tight and bumped repeatedly entering the first turn, settled into stride between horses, but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out.
