Footnotes

IN THE BEAT was taken in hand, tucked in to save ground, commenced his rally inside the three furlong marker, slipped through entering the stretch, kept on through a rail skimming drive and was up in the final strides. RADIANT TALENT was unruly in post parade, unseated his jockey and hit the rail, rushed to the lead, set the pressured pace off of the inside, fought on through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. MR SATURDAY prompted the pace three wide, kept on well through a long drive but grudgingly gave way. CASA DE CAMBIO settled in hand between horses, shifted out four wide entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. RISKY RECOVERY chased the pace five wide to the stretch and faded. DEVOTED WILDCAT bumped with BARNYARD FIDDLER at the start, moved into contention four wide, but came up empty after a half and gave way. GOINGONGONE was forwardly placed toward the inside through the turn and retreated. LIGHTLY WOUND was allowed to settle, circled six wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. CRAFTY MACHO failed to respond. CAPTAIN CRASH was pinched back at the start and showed little thereafter. BARNYARD FIDDLER was bumped at the start and was never a factor. HARVARD went greenly in traffic and stopped before going a quarter.
