Footnotes

LEAD STORY, reserved near the inside soon after the start, went along under patient handling, remained next to the inner rail when advancing on the far turn and into the stretch, reached the front a furlong out when sharply roused, then increased her advantage under energetic hand urging. MAYO ON THE SIDE was hustled early to gain the lead, raced three wide, managed a clear margin into the stretch but wasn't a match for the winner in the drive while superior to the others. CLOAKOF VAGUENESS settled three wide early, was unhurried for six furlongs, remained near the inside entering the lane and improved position while no threat to the top two. MISTY SIXES moved in behind front-running MAYO ON THE SIDE early, raced in contention to the final quarter, came out four or five wide and was empty. TAKE CHARGE LADY stalked the pace from early on while between rivals three or four wide, was asked for her best when in closest attendance to the pacesetter leaving the three-eighth pole, angled five wide for the drive and flattened out. FIRCFROFT settled four wide and failed to rally. SWEETWATER PROMISE broke in the air, then stumbled when landing, was gathered up and never menaced. GOLDEN MARLIN stalked the pace four or five wide for nearly seven furlongs and faded. RHIANA in contention four or five wide for six furlongs, weakened thereafter.
