Footnotes

GREATER GOOD, reserved near the inside soon after the start, was patiently handled, came out four wide midway on the far turn, was alertly angled back to the inside entering the lane, came through fairly close quarters along the rail at the furlong grounds and drove clear late under energetic handling. **RUSH BAY** settled near the inside early, followed the leaders three wide on the backstretch, awaited room briefly at the five-sixteenths, was four wide when straightened for the drive, loomed outside the winner late but wasn't a match. **WILD DESERT**, reserved near the inside early, moved with the winner while outside that one five wide on the far turn, came out eight abreast when straightened for the drive and finished willingly. **B. B. BEST** came out bumping **DRUM MAJOR** at the start, went up soon after to force the pace three abreast, gained the advantage just before going a half, raced three or four wide while opening a clear margin in the upper stretch, then weakened late. **MAGNA GRADUATE** gained a forward position in behind the leaders entering the first turn, followed them four wide on the backstretch, leaned in at the five-sixteenths pole and bumped for a stride with **STORM SURGE**, loomed boldly while coming a bit wider for the drive and flattened out late. **STORM SURGE** went up early to vie for the lead between foes, battled close up for six furlongs, was bumped for a stride by **MAGNA GRADUATE** approaching the stretch and weakened. **DRUM MAJOR**, bumped at the break by **B. B. BEST**, raced five or six wide, was a factor for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. **SOCIAL PROBATION**, a bit awkward at the start, raced within easy striking distance five wide to the final quarter and faltered. **HIGHGROVE** gained a slim lead inside early, battled close up on for a half, gave way on the far turn and was distanced in the stretch when not persevered with.
