Footnotes

MS. PURR gained the lead early, controlled the pace from the three path and was ridden hard in the drive to hold sway. THIN AIR, unhurried early, advanced near the inside entering the lane, eased out four wide for the drive and finished willingly. GLITTERATION, rated in behind the leaders from early on, eased outside the winner four wide for the drive, loomed boldly and wasn't good enough. TAP'N TANGO, well placed in behind the leaders early, was checked between foes when in tight leaving the half-mile ground, angled five or six wide when straightened for the drive and lacked a late account. IDEAL SCENARIO, outrun for a half, made a run five or six wide approaching the stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum when straightened into the lane. WINIKINS angled in early to press the winner three or four wide, raced close up for six furlongs and gradually weakened. HALODRAMATIC tracked the pace five wide to the stretch and tired. SHUTTERBUG never menaced. UNBRIDLED APPEAL followed the leaders in a striking position five or six for three-quarters and weakened. CRYSTAL MARINA settled near the inside and never menaced. GOODSPRINGS raced near the inside and tired. CHAFFED LIPS was outrun.
