Footnotes

BLAME settled in hand four wide, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, came five wide, poked his head in front with a furlong to run and held gamely through the drive. MISREMEMBERED attended the pace four wide, moved up to gain a narrow lead with a quarter to run, angled in entering the stretch, fought on gamely but grudgingly gave in late. EINSTEIN (BRZ) tucked in behind rivals entering the first turn within contention, bid between horses entering the stretch and was getting to the top two late. GIANT OAK hopped at the start to get away slowly, settled into stride off of the inside, angled out to make his bid, came five wide and finished willingly. ANAK NAKAL was allowed to settle, made a bold bid circling five wide, but weakened from between horses and faded. DUBIOUS MISS was unhurried, angled in to save ground, swung six wide to make a late rally and improved his position. BULLSBAY advanced from between rivals three deep, shifted out four wide entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. DEMARCATION

settled along the hedge, angled out to make a late rally from between horses but failed to seriously threaten. MACHO AGAIN was unhurried into stride, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. KISS THE KID contended along the inside, worked his way off of the inside leaving the second turn, lacked room entering the stretch, steadied near the furlong marker and showed little thereafter. YOU AND I FOREVER saved ground to little avail. ANARKO (CHI) opened clear to set the pace, was collared after six furlong and gave way readily. ETCHED chased the pace three wide, angled in entering the stretch but came up empty and retreated. TIMBER RESERVE was forwardly placed four wide to the stretch and stopped.
