HE AIN'T RIGHT pressed the pace two wide, gained a narrow advantage entering the stretch, battled through a long drive and gamely held sway. LINEBACKER settled in hand off of the inside, closed the gap leaving the turn, split horses late and was just up to earn the place. KEEPINONESTEPAHEAD hopped at the start, was allowed to settle, circled five wide to make his bid, but lacked the needed late response. BOBBY B. GOODE set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed leaving the turn and grudgingly gave way during the drive. KING ANDREW made a middle move four wide, offered a mild bid but weakened from between horses and faded. WILLBRITTE settled in the second flight and failed to respond. ALL ON THE LION broke awkwardly and showed little thereafter. MIDNIGHT CRUSH was forwardly placed along the inside but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out.
