PATTI'S REGAL SONG attended the pace between horses, angled in entering the stretch, found room and wore down her rivals in the final yards. SHAMELESS settled in hand, made a bold bid four wide, loomed large with a furlong to run, continued on willingly but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. SHAKER LAKES pressed the pace three deep, forged a narrow lead with a quarter to run, was collared between horses in the drive and grudgingly gave way late. HOME FRIES contended between horses, angled out entering the stretch and improved her position five wide. CHAMPAGNE JANE stumbled and veered out at the start, rushed to contention three wide, but weakened from between horses entering the stretch and faded. COUNTRY SINGER opened clear to set the pace, disputed the issue to the stretch, but gave way readily once headed. PANTANO lost her footing at the start and was away slowly, settled in the second flight five wide and failed to respond. SAPPHIRESDIAMONDS was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and dropped out. KAZOOM was outrun. MISS SIBY hesitated at the start to get away well behind her field, dropped further back and trailed throughout.
