BRETHREN drifted out at the start after an alert beginning, settled early, advanced five wide after five furlongs, challenged approaching the stretch, drew clear in midstretch and stayed clear while under steady urging. EL GRAYLING lost his footing at the start, recovered quickly, pressed the pace four wide while reserved, challenged on the turn and held on gamely to the finish. JUSTIN PHILLIP stumbled at the start, recovered quickly, vied for the lead three wide and weakened in the rive. FREDRIK THE GREAT reserved off the inside, improved his position while no threat. MERIDIAN MAGIC within striking distance off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. WAR WHOOP outrun early, raced five wide into the stretch and could not menace. BLUEGRASS JAM forced the pace along the inside and tired. SAN ANTONE alternated for the lead off the inside and gave way. A. P. GUNNER within striking distance four wide, faded.
