Footnotes

WINCHILL closest to the pace three wide, challenged on the turn and edged off late under pressure. APPEALING IMAGE within striking distance, raced in the five path on the turn and finished willingly to be up for the place late. CITY COOL set the pace near the rail, responded when challenged on the turn but weakened late. RAZMATAZ stumbled at the start, recovered to be close up three wide but tired. DEVIL TRAIN prominent off the inside, steadied late on the turn then lacked a rally. JENNA'S LEMON never far back four wide, tired in the drive. BIG BLUE CABOOSE outrun early, raced in the five path on the turn and was no threat. KEEN CASE was no factor four wide. IMPERSONATOR close up along the inside, faded.
