Footnotes

SOUTHEASTER gained the lead early, made the pace three or four wide, managed a clear advantage into the final furlong and was kept to her task. SLAMMIN' LIL, never far back and near the inside, continued along the rail into the stretch and was second best. TOMORROWS DANCER worked her way in early to press the pace four wide, raced close up throughout but couldn't offer a final response. DONANDRU'S DREAM, outrun to the stretch while in behind foes, came out nine wide for the drive and was gaining late. SPECIALITY tracked the pace four or five wide, loomed boldly from that position into the final furlong but faltered. KEIAI SAKURA, within striking distance while between foes four or five wide into the stretch, was empty the last eighth. CLASSIC HABIT, outrun to the stretch, improved position inside but wasn't a serious threat. TONTO BAR GIRL, well placed inside from early on, moved near the inside, was asked for her best nearing the final quarter but flattened out in the drive. COMME IL FAUT wasn't a factor. RED AT THE HELM, six wide, tired leaving the turn. GOLD'N GLORY (JPN) tired early. LIN MI LIN never was prominent and raced seven or eight wide in the stretch.
