Footnotes

PLATINUM EDITION, slammed at the start by IRISH GAMBLER from the outside and forced in, jolted with DEFY LOGIC, tracked the pace five wide, took over in the upper stretch, edged clear, then was hard ridden to hold sway. C. C. MINISTER swerved out at the start on DEFY LOGIC, forced that one out, was never far back while five or six wide and slowly was gaining at the end. DEFY LOGIC, bumped soundly at the start and forced out on PLATINUM EDITION, raced four or five wide while outrun early, angled inside the leaders in deep stretch but couldn't muster the needed response. FAIR WINDS, well placed early, moved inside, lost a bit of position on the turn, eased out four wide for the drive but lacked a serious late response. STOKER, outrun early, came out seven or eight wide for the drive, reached contention a furlong out and was empty late. GOLD ADVENTURE failed to rally. IRISH GAMBLER ducked in on PLATINUM EDITION, gained the lead, raced four wide and tired upon going a half. LORD FOXCROFT close up four or five wide early, moved inside on the turn, continued forwardly for a half and tired. BRAVE 'N AWAY was never close. This race was hand timed.
