After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 15, 2008 with 26 nominations.

EINSTEIN (BRZ) was well placed to attend the pace three deep, ranged up to engage COMMENTATOR entering the stretch, wore down that one and edged clear. DELIGHTFUL KISS was unhurried into stride and dropped well back, came five wide to make his bid, finished full of run but was unable to reach the winner. COMMENTATOR opened clear to set the pace well off of the inside, angled in entering the second turn, was headed nearing the three-sixteenths pole and weakened during the drive. MAGNA GRADUATE settled saving ground within striking distance, shifted out off the rail entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. WAYZATA BAY was jostled between horses at the start and clipped heels, dropped far back, made a belated gain entering the stretch but failed to seriously threaten. DOMINICAN broke inwardly bumping WAYZATA BAY, tracked the pace three wide, made a middle move to close the gap, loomed a danger with five-sixteenths to run but failed to sustain the drive. ANAK NAKAL contended three wide under a snug hold, angled out four wide leaving the second turn but came up empty during the drive and gave way.
