Footnotes

JUST LIKE WILLIAM settled saving ground, shifted out off of the inside and ranged into striking distance from between horses through the second turn, came three wide to continue the drive, reeled in the leaders and forged a narrow lead with a sixteenth to run, then was all out to keep the resurgent SAUL TO PAUL at bay in the final yards. SAUL TO PAUL stalked the pace along the inside, angled out four wide to launch his bid, loomed large entering the stretch, assumed command with a furlong to run, was collared late and dug in gamely to meet the bid but was denied in the final stride. D. C. NINER tracked the pace three wide, moved up to engage the leaders with three furlongs to run, disputed the issue to the sixteenth marker, weakened during the drive but maintained the show. SHIP'S CABIN set the pressured pace two wide, opened clear after a half, was headed on the second turn and gave way entering the lane. CAJUN PRIZE broke in the air to get away slowly, settled in hand two wide, moved with the winner through the second turn but failed to sustain the bid. REV CAYCE angled in to save ground and was unhurried into stride, angled out entering the stretch to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. Z GREY was taken well back and passed only his tiring rivals. SAINT BAYOU GOLD pressed the pace along the inside to the second turn and dropped out. SILVER DEMON was unhurried three wide and showed little.
