Footnotes

BULLSBAY tracked the pace off of the inside, reeled in DA' TARA nearing the quarter pole and quickly kicked clear to score with something left. LET IT ROCK was unhurried into stride, responded when roused nearing the three-eighths pole, closed the gap three wide through the second turn, angled in entering the stretch and continued on well to earn the place. DA' TARA opened clear to dictate terms, was collared leaving the second turn, proved no match for the winner, weakened during the drive and settled for a minor award. REAL APPEAL was forwardly placed three wide, offered a mild bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out entering the stretch and failed to sustain the drive. ITSALLBOUTTHECHASE was allowed to settle into stride, launched a mild bid five wide through the second turn but faltered during the drive and faded. M B SEA steadied from tight quarters entering the first turn, settled saving ground but lacked a response when called upon. ALLSAROTT was hung wide while never far back, but came up empty after a half and dropped out. SUMMER BOOK was through early.
