Footnotes

LIDO PALACE (CHI), reserved early along the inside, eased out entering the backstretch while continuing under wraps five or six wide, edged in a bit, was tapped on his muzzle several times leaving the three furlong marker when attempting to get out, advanced six wide when straightened for the drive and closed under strong handling to prevail. CRAFTY SHAW gained a forward position early while maneuvering in four wide, went along under careful handling, reached the front just prior to going six furlongs, showed the way into deep stretch but was outfished. HERO'S TRIBUTE, difficult to load into the gate, was rated in behind the leaders early while near the inside, continued in that manner, made a menacing run five wide into the stretch, had aim but wasn't good enough. TENPINS broke running to gain a slight edge while edging inside, showed the way two or three wide, lost the advantage just before going six furlongs and held on stubbornly the remainder. NAJRAN went up early to force the issue from between foes, battled with TENPINS and CRAFTY SHAW, dueling with the latter on even terms into the stretch and weakened when straightened for the drive. DOLLAR BILL, angled in four or five wide while outrun early, swung out 10 wide for the drive and offered a mild gain while unable to seriously menace. X COUNTRY, outrun to the far turn and five or six wide, circled foes 12 wide into the lane and passed tired ones. AMERICAN STYLE raced near the inside most of the way but never menaced. HAIL THE CHIEF (GB), well placed to the stretch while three or four wide, flattened out in the drive. GANDER, four or five wide most of the way, wasn't a factor. GENEROUS ROSI (GB), rated three or four wide early, was finished upon going six furlongs.
