Footnotes

EMILY'S MARK, away well, angled in early to force the pace, reached the front in the upper stretch, swerved in for a stride leaving the three-sixteenths pole, then was hard ridden the remainder. PRINCEAPECIA, checked in tight quarters at the start when bumped by SYMBOL OF LOVE, was outrun to the turn, raced in behind rivals, split horses four wide at the eighth pole, then was going well at the end. FRENCH REIGN, never far back, made a bold run outside the winner five wide at the eighth pole, gained about even terms for the lead but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. SYMBOL OF LOVE came out at the start bumping PRINCEAPECIA, was outrun for a half, made a run six wide into the upper stretch but failed to gain in the late going. SPA CITY, in contention while racing between horses into the stretch, lacked a serious late bid while improving position. SUNDAY SPORT moved up early to vie for the lead from between foes, took a narrow advantage just prior to going a quarter, kicked clear on the turn, made the pace into the stretch, lost the edge to EMILY'S MARK, was steadied behind that one when she swerved in at the three-sixteenths, then weakened. SHAKE THE DUST, in front after the start, lost the advantage to SUNDAY SPORT on the backstretch, continued forwardly into the final furlong and faltered. FLIPETTE, with in easy striking distance while

five or six wide into the final furlong, flattened out. CONSOMME tired leaving the turn. TAP THE SKY was outrun. SECRETIVE raced inside but never menaced. KOBEMON faded midway on the turn. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN INVOLVING EMILY'S MARK DURING THE STRETCH RUN. FOLLOWING A REVIEW OF THE VIDEO TAPE REPLAYS, STEWARDS FOUND INSUFFICIENT EVIDENCE FOR ACTION.
