Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs; two races other than maiden or claiming 4 lbs; a race other than maiden or claiming 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Closed Saturday, November 15, 2003 with 30 nominations. Trophy to winning owner. The Golden Rod Stakes winner will automatically be nominated to the 2004 Kentucky Oaks, as far as nomination fee.








Footnotes

BE GENTLE sprinted clear and was angled to the inside on the first turn, set the pace near the rail, responded willingly when challenged by LOTTA KIM on the second turn and proved best under pressure. LOTTA KIM closest to the winner while outside that one, made an earnest bit midway through the second turn and held on gamely in the drive. DYNVILLE within striking distance from the outset, moved between rivals on the second turn, came to the inside for the drive and finished with good courage while lacking room late. GALLOPING GAL outrun early along the inside, angled out after a half, came out five wide leaving the second turn and improved her position while no real threat. LENATAREESE forwardly placed three wide, moved to challenge the top pair on the second turn, held on well to the furlong marker and tired. JINNY'S GOLD angled in a bit when within striking distance, saved ground on the second turn when moving closer, then tired in the final furlong. SHEER LUCK outrun early, raced in the two path around the second turn and was no threat. STELLAR

JAYNE outsprinted early three wide, angled in, saved ground on the second turn and was no factor. BIRTHDAY SONG close up along the inside, steadied midway through the first turn, recovered, angled outside on the backstretch, raced four wide on the second turn and faded. SISTER STAR was no factor. TWILIGHT GALLOP forwardly placed three wide, was carried six wide entering the stretch and gave way.
