**Footnotes**

WILDCAT SHOES gained the lead at the start, edged clear, was engaged nearing the stretch from the outside by WILD JIM and DANIELTOWN, reopened a clear advantage, then was fully extended to last under left-handed whipping. CEDAR POINT, outrun for a half, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and was going well at the end. WILD JIM, well placed from the outset while four or five wide, engaged the winner concluding the turn but flattened out the last eighth. OBLAT, within striking distance throughout, raced six wide into the final furlong and failed to offer a further response. BLUSHING INDIAN, outrun to the stretch, found his best stride late while seven or eight wide. MAN OF CONQUEST had no rally. EXCITING METRO, bumped at the start, was well placed inside into the stretch, then flattened out the last eighth. DANIELTOWN, forwardly placed but six wide during the early going, edged in on the turn, loomed prominently entering the upper stretch but weakened soon after. EXPLOITED STORM tired early. CAT BUSTER forced the pace early, continued forwardly to the stretch and tired. OHWHATAPARADE failed to menace. PAPER MAN drifted in at the start bumping EXCITING METRO, never was a factor and raced 10 wide in the stretch.
