Weight 122 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. The Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes winner will automatically be nominated to the 2009 Triple Crown, as far as nomination fee. Closed Saturday, November 15, 2008 with 25 nominations.

Footnotes

BEETHOVEN forwardly placed along the inside, challenged from the rail approaching the stretch and proved best under pressure. GIANT OAK reserved for a half, made a solid five wide middle move, reached a forward position late on the second turn then rallied willingly to miss. CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN set the early pace three wide, angled in a bit on the backstretch, maintained a comfortable lead into the second turn, was a bit tentative crossing two shadows on the second turn losing a bit of momentum, responded willingly when challenged by the winner with a quarter mile to go and held on gamely to also miss. ZION pressed the early pace, dropped back a bit before a half, stayed within striking distance to the stretch and tired in the drive. STORMALORY reserved off the inside, made a good four wide move after a half but could not sustain the bid. JAZZANDTHEMAGICIAN closest to the pace inside, moved off the rail on the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. COAL BARON reserved along the inside, was no threat. STAR OF DAVID within striking distance, raced in the four path on the second turn and tired in the final quarter. BIG SURF outrun, was pulled up in deep stretch and vanned off.
