**Footnotes**

EL SEASON was always in striking distance, got in gear on the outside going to the final jump and cruised to the lead after the last fence. EZ MAC assumed command from the beginning, still had the advantage jumping the last but was no match for the winner, but still second best. GENERAL PARTNER was allowed to settle, got up close going down the backside for the final time, was right there when he jumped the last badly losing momentum but still had enough for the third spot. JOHANN STAR raced in the rear, and passed a tired rival on the final turn. HE'S A FIREBALL was through after a mile and faded.
