SOUTHERN ADMIRAL raced in hand along the outside while featuring prominently throughout, wore down rival after matching strides along the backstretch the final time, took command with two furlongs to go and kicked clear. PRIMERO PERU was always a factor, took the lead on the second circuit and set the pace from there, dueled inside the winner along the backstretch but was outkicked in the final quarter. BERMUDA was in tight through the home stretch the first time, was in good position for a bid along the rail but was no match. FU SAN trailed the field to the late stages and never menaced. AMERICAN CROSSING showed a quick foot in the opening half to be in front at the first call then gave way steadily. ARDAGH pulled up at the last fence.
