Footnotes

TIZSILK was reserved in the early stages, advanced steadily around the final turn then responded when asked for an extra effort to quickly make up ground along the inside in the final sixteenth and was up just in time. AIR MAGGY was allowed to settle in good position, made his way to a striking position with mild urging, drew even with the late leader and dueled outside that one to the upper stretch, bested that foe in the late going to be in front with few strides remaining then was caught by the fast closing TIZSILK on the inside. WILD FOR GOLD was forwardly placed from the outset, set just off the leaders while, moved up to gain the advantage three furlongs from the wire with a bid between rivals, held sway to the turn when he was collared by AIR MAGGY, dueled with that one to the deep stretch and was outfinished in the late going. RED LETTER DAY maintained a slight advantage while getting pressure from FARNDALE, traded strides with that one to the final half mile, surrendered the lead to WILD FOR GOLD when that one offered a run, then retreated when asked for a further run. IMPERIAL GIN was not a threat. ITS A SCHOOL NIGHT never factored. STRAIGHT TO IT raced in good position but tired in the late going a pulled up at the last fence. FARNDALE loomed prominently in the early going while matching strides with RED LETTER DAY, then stopped when passed by rival with three furlongs to go and pulled up at the last fence. UNION ARMY fell at the fifth fence.
