### Footnotes

GOLDEN SLAMMER was unhurried early, gained ground on the backside for the final time, was up close entering the stretch, got the lead jumping the second last jump, and just held off the whole rushing field in the final strides. GREAT HALO trailed the field and was never asked to run until the head of the stretch, then he came with a rush on the outside over the final two jumps and just missed at the wire. CLASS CLASSIC stalked pace from the beginning was in the mix over the last two jumps but just could not get there. DYNASKILL was never out of contention, gave up a little ground at the head of the stretch then went inside came again over the final two jumps, but just could not get up for the win. HOT RIZE was right there, saved ground on the inside on the final turn, had a clear run over the final two jumps but just could not gain further ground. CLASS REAL ROCK took command from the beginning, had a slight advantage entering the stretch then tired.
