VALID SPRINTER set all the pace and held gamely to be clear under strong pressure. PASSED pressed the pace from the outside, raced three wide and finished second best. SITE ALARM was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide in the stretch and finished willingly to the wire. MFAZI raced towards the inside throughout and made a mild late gain. SIR MORGAN saved ground and had no late response. HERO TAKES IT ALL raced four wide and never was a factor. MORE GOLD TO TELL was off slowly, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. OUR FRIEND VERN saved ground and never threatened. SHOWBOAT WILLY pressed the pace from the outside and tired. ORPHAN RUNNING showed little.
