**Footnotes**

CO SASSY stalked the leaders racing out from the rail while never far back, moved to challenge into the far turn while gaining the inside, continued on a clear lead through midstretch then held safe late under steady handling. DEPUTY'S WHIRL stalked the pace from three wide early, moved out to five wide heading up the backstretch then appeared to brush with RACHELE R'S QUEEN into the far turn, continued five wide into the lane and closed but could not run down the winner. GENERAL ASSERTION moved up four wide to bid into the far turn and have aim but lacked a final response through the lane. RACHELE R'S QUEEN moved clear in the first turn racing out from the rail, brushed with DEPUTY'S WHIRL while three wide going to the far turn and tired. SENORITA CONCHITA stalked the leaders while four to five wide to the far turn and tired. SUNDAY DANCER was not a threat racing outside. COUPON CLIPPER was close up early from along the inside and tired.
