Footnotes

SWEET BOY settled back off the early pace racing out from the rail, swung five wide heading up the backstretch to launch his rally, continued five and six wide through the far turn and closed determinedly to be up late. SPOOKY THUNDER tracked the early leaders racing four and five wide, rallied through the lane and closed to narrowly miss. SAMMY WILL TELL contested the pace outside MATTCIELO to move clear into the far turn, opened the advantage into the lane then could not contain the top pair late. MAGNIFICENT BLUFF stalked the leaders racing three and four wide, angled five wide to follow the winner into the lane but could not produce the needed late run. SKWHIRL angled to the inside leaving the first turn, moved to challenge in late backstretch but saw the opening along the rail close and stopped his rally then could not mount another bid. MATTCIELO forced the pace from inside SAMMY WILL TELL while racing out from the rail and weakened. GIN HE KIN HE broke to the outside to come away slowly and tired racing five and six wide throughout.
