ENCHATIVEMEDALLIST stalked the leader racing three and four wide, rallied through the far turn then angled outside that one in upper stretch and moved clear under steady handling. CRAFTY ZAVATA moved to a clear lead racing in the three to four path then could not handle the winner in the lane while narrowly saving position late. GINNIE was five and six wide through the first turn while just off the early pace, moved closer from outside to bid five wide into the lane and could not produce the needed late run. RUN SEVILLE RUN saved ground to the far turn, angled five wide nearing the lane and had no rally. CROWN ROYALTY was always back while widest throughout. BANG ON was not a factor racing four wide. EVE N TOUCH chased the pace from about three wide and tired while five wide into the lane. MOSS BRIDGE saved ground and tired.
