RARE CRYSTAL moved out to make a quick bid three wide heading up the backstretch and move clear into the far turn, took command into the lane, ducked in briefly around the eighth marker but continued on strongly and held safe under steady handling. SMACKTALKER saved ground while unhurried early, rallied along the rail through the far turn and continued with good energy in the lane but could not threaten the winner. NIKKI NINE dueled on the pace from inside KACHINA RIVER while headed by that one through the opening quarter, settled back and weakened but dug in through the lane only to lose the place late. KACHINA RIVER dueled from outside NIKKI NINE and weakened through the lane to lose position. SHELBY DEE could not threaten racing three wide. MISSION LASS bobbled at the start, chased the pace from three or four wide and tired.
