DON'S WILL settled off the pace racing three and four wide early, moved inside heading up the backstretch to rally through the far turn, angled out to bid four wide into the lane and moved clear under steady handling. MISTER SUH showed good early speed while four and five wide in the first turn to draw clear and move off heading up the backstretch then could not go with the winner in the lane while holding clear for his position. A PIE TO GO contested the early lead from four wide while between rivals, continued evenly in the lane but could not go with the top pair. WERRAGOINGHOME moved up five wide in the far turn and could not threaten late. SNEAKIE PETESKI moved up three and four wide but lacked a closing response. HISWAYORTHEHIGHWAY broke into the side of the gate, moved outside heading up the backstretch and moved up six wide into the lane. SAND HILLER saved ground and was not a threat. SMART SHOOTER contested the early lead from four wide in the first turn and tired. INDIAN KNIGHT broke down fatally in the far turn.
