Footnotes

FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD moved to a short lead racing out from the rail, continued well in the lane and held sway under steady handling. SCENIC SHADOW was shuffled back between rivals after the break, dropped back off the pace then rallied four and five wide through the far turn to gain the place but could not reach the winner. AWESOME BREW stalked the pace from outside to move five wide in the far turn but could not run down the top pair. B G GIFT EXCHANGE tracked the leaders while along the inside, bid nearing the lane but weakened a bit in the drive. POWER SWEEP LEFT showed speed outside rivals to fan six wide out of the first turn, remained outside in good position but weakened a bit. FIVE ALARM tucked inside going to the first turn, saved ground and lacked a final closing response. SCHWARTZBEWITHYOU saved ground, moved in traffic through the far turn and could not threaten late. NAFIR'S LAD was shuffled back between rivals at the break and lacked a rally racing three wide. I THINK IT IS was always back while saving ground then swung widest into the lane. ZACK CAPE contested the early lead and tired racing three to four wide.
